The painting is an original, oil media titled “Feather Maiden” by Penni Anne Cross ~ Alaska, USA. The painting is currently custom framed.

Overview description - The image category/description for “Feather Maiden” is Native American genre; an impressionist/realist image of a Native American woman in traditional Native American garb kneeling while facing the viewer. The background is dark with a striped blanket within view.

The dimensions for “Feather Maiden” are approximately 20 inches x 24 inches unframed and 24 inches x 28 inches with the custom frame. Glass is not included on this framed work. The painting and frame are in excellent condition with no damage present.
