The painting is an oil media original image/design titled “study for Billie hears the rain” by Penni Anne Cross ~ Alaska, USA. The painting is currently custom framed.

Overview description - The image category/description for “study for Billie hears the rain” is Native American genre; impressionist/realist image of a Native American woman working at a weaving loom with a child in the background. Background is a watercolor wash in light grey ~ greens.

The dimensions for “study for Billie hears the rain” are 27 inches x 33 inches unframed and 32 inches x 38 inches with the custom frame. Glass is included on this framed work. The painting and frame are in excellent condition with no damage present.
