Overview description - The image category/description for “Tying her boots” is Native American genre; an impressionist/realist image of a seated Native American woman in traditional Native American garb facing the viewer, tying her boots. The background is a natural, outdoor scene in realistic earth tones.

The dimensions for “Tying her boots” are approximately 21 inches x 12 inches unframed and 25 inches x 16 inches with the custom frame. Glass is included on this framed work. The painting and frame are in excellent condition with no damage present.
